You will be expected to collect your work on Sunday 3rd August between 10am and 4pm. Again, if this is a problem, let us know and we will try our best to accommodate you.

We suggest applicants volunteer as stewards in the gallery during opening hours. The gallery will be open from Saturday 26th July - Saturday 2nd August 11am- 6pm. This is an excellent opportunity to discuss your work with the public and also help the project. We would be obliged if you could note your availability in the form below. If you are unavailable to steward, this will not affect your application.

Artists are welcome to sell their work, however, Artlandish will take a 20% commission fee from each sale. Please consider this when pricing your work.

There will be an open view event on Saturday 26th July from 6pm. (No invitation needed and a chance to meet the artists and other members of the Artlandish community)
